- IV. Discussion and Possible Board Action on the Following:
 - A. School board minutes considering the benchmarks and other measures outlined in EO 2020-51 for determining when to reopen school for in-person instruction.
 - a. Karen Kordon presented the benchmarks for safely opening schools, the thresholds for meeting the benchmarks and the amount of time the threshold would have to be met for each area. Karen went on to explain that 2 of the 3 benchmarks have been met and the 3rd benchmark is currently in the green.

 - a. Karen Kordon presented Camelback Academy's Health Mitigation Plan, including health, facilities, and keeping vulnerable populations safe. Zanndra Enriquez asked about the on-site support students, their compliance with distancing and mask policies. Carlos Ortega asked about the probability of returning to on-campus instruction for quarter 2.
 - C. Face Covering Policy
 - a. Karen Kordon explained the face covering policy, including the requirement of all staff, students and visitors 2 years and older to wear face masks while on campus.
